

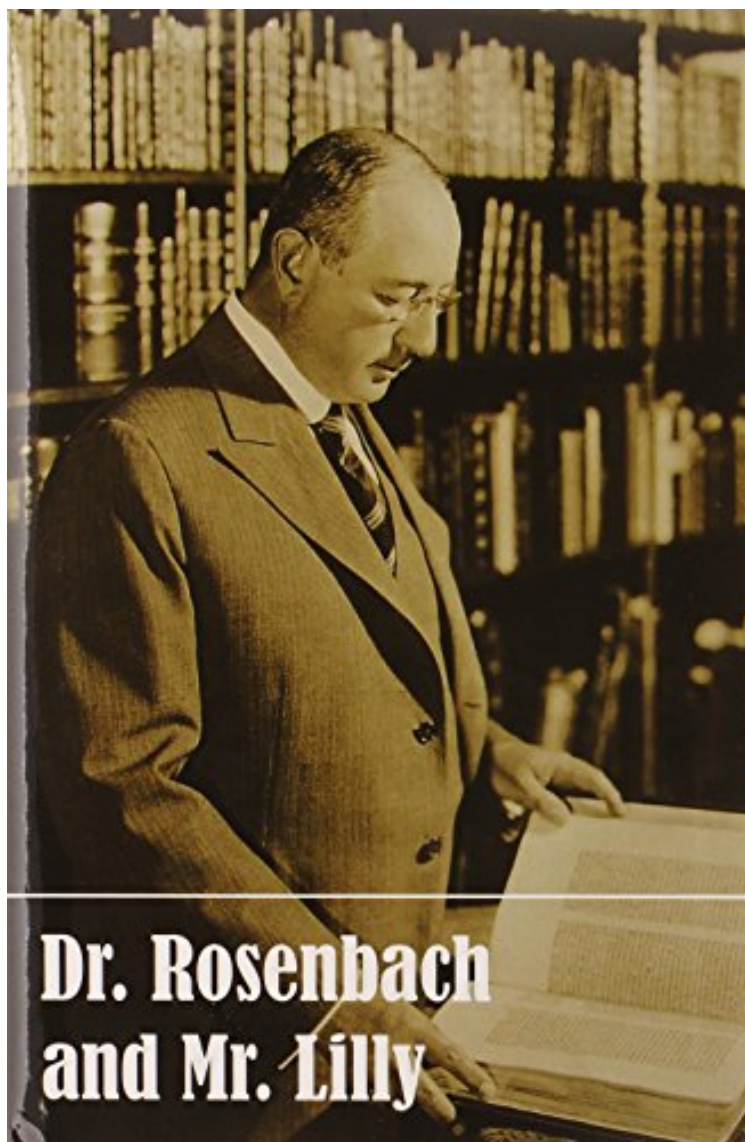

The Lilly Library at Indiana University is named for Mr. Lilly because of his substantial gift of books and manuscripts to the University. I have not yet read the book but know Mr. Silver personally and am aware of his scholarship and writing skill.

There was a time when book collecting was big news. In the first half of the twentieth century, some of America's leading financiers, executives, and philanthropists played ""this book-collecting game"" (as A. Edward Newton called it) and competed with each other for the finest books and manuscripts in the world.
