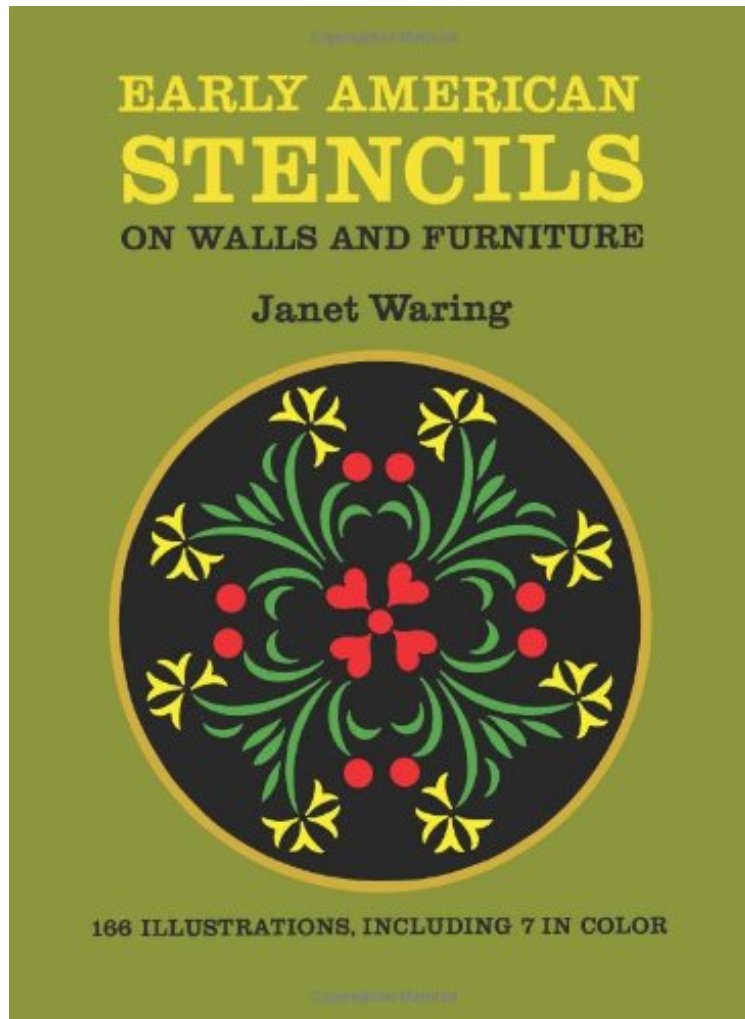

It's still great - it shows entire wall patterns and even entire walls. Most designs photocopy acceptably enough for enlargement for you to duplicate. Covers walls, floors, furniture and theorems, including photos of actual stencils used by William Eaton.
