

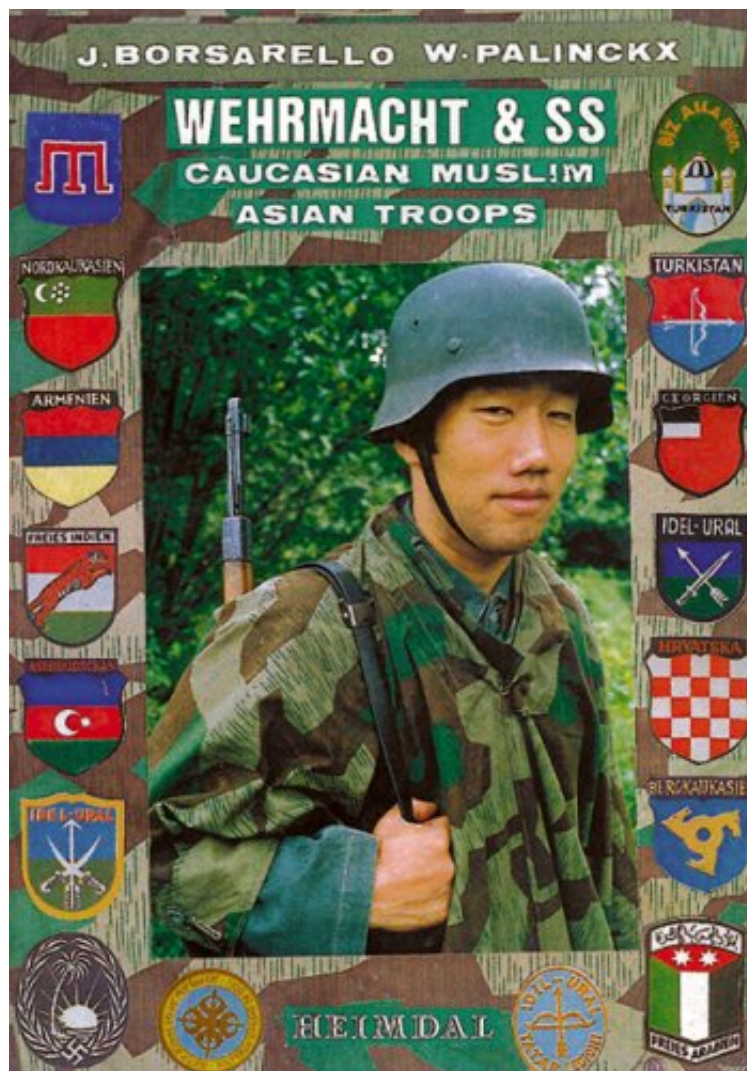

After huge losses on the Russian front in 1942, the need for replacements was high. As a result, more than one million Bosnians, Arabs, Mongols, Asians, Indians and men from the area of the Caucasus Mountains were enlisted into both the German army and the SS. This book documents the history of these new recruits to the Nazi ranks and illustrates them in a series of archive photographs showing the men and their uniforms, together with reproductions of unit badges and flags. 300 photographs document their activities, plus badges, flags and maps.
